 - Fidelity Extensions (FREXT) approved
- Licensing terms set
- ■50% less bits *or better* now
- Needed by all Video Distributors

What are the bit rates?

- Standard Definition
 - ■1.5 to 2 Mbts today (Full Resolution)
 - ■30% less near term
- High Definition
 - 8 to 10 Mbts today; 5 Mbts 1080i demo
 - At least 30% less very near term
 - Stat Mux for even further reductions



What is the timing?

- Encoders outpacing decoders
 - Multiple vendors can now deliver
- More decoders shortly
 - SW based systems now
 - Decoding chips <u>finally</u> releasing now
 - Professional decoders
 - Wide open STB market = more innovation
 - IP based STB trend



No Risk Interoperability

- Reference designs accelerated last year's efforts
- Stream exchanges > one year
- Encoders & Decoders now work together
- Efforts continue on new STBs
- Veritable plethora of announcements & options
